RE: 2022 Cape Mabou Community Pasture Information

As you are aware, the Agri-Commodity Management Association is now managing the operations of the Cape Mabou Community Pasture for the 2022 season. Please see the below highlights of payments to occur for the 2022 season, which has been adjusted from previous years:

- **A deposit of 50% of total season fees is due with animal arrival on July 8th/9th, 2022. This can be paid by cash, cheque, Visa, MasterCard, American Express or email money transfer.**

The remaining 50% of season fees will be invoiced to the patron once cattle have been removed at the pasture closure, October 7th-8th, 2022. Veterinary and medication costs will be added to this final invoice, if applicable.

- **All patrons who wish to enter cattle on pasture must have paid the Annual Pasture Subscription fee of \$25.00 (\$28.75 + HST), as well as completed the subscription form.**
- **A late payment fee of \$5.00 per head will be charged for payments not received by July 29th, 2022.**
